Program:

The Economic Outlook for Buffalo and Upstate New York

This presentation will examine the recent performance of the Buffalo area economy within



the greater context of upstate New York. It will show that while growth remains somewhat slow, there has been some upward momentum that began during the second half of 2014. The manufacturing sector has been weighing down employment gains, while the education and health sectors have remained strong contributors to job creation. The presentation will also show that the median worker's wage in Buffalo has shown some growth in recent years, even as the median worker's wage in the U.S. has declined, and that Buffalo's median worker enjoys a higher wage than the nation. The housing market has continued to perform well, with home prices climbing steadily, and household debt remains quite low in the region.

Presenter: Richard Deitz, Federal Reserve Bank

Richard Deitz serves as Assistant Vice President and Senior Economist for the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, and has been with the Federal Reserve since 1998. He provides economic analysis of upstate New York for the Federal Reserve System, and often consults with state and local governments on regional economic issues.

Prior to joining the Federal Reserve, Mr. Deitz served as a professor of economics for several upstate New York colleges and universities, including Canisius College, the University at Buffalo, the Rochester Institute of Technology, Saint Lawrence University, and Binghamton University.

Mr. Deitz serves on the Board of Economic Advisors for the New York State Division of the Budget and the New York State Assembly Ways and Means Committee. He is past president of the New York State Economics Association and the Regional New York Center for Financial Training.

Mr. Deitz created the Empire State Manufacturing Survey, and has published works on issues facing the upstate New York economy, the labor market for college graduates, and factors underlying regional economic growth.

Mr. Deitz has a Ph.D. in Economics from Binghamton University.

Scholarship Applications Now Available

ISM-Buffalo is accepting applications for the **William J. Gamble Memorial Scholarship**

to be awarded to a member of ISM-Buffalo or the spouse, son, daughter, niece, nephew or grandchild of a member of ISM-Buffalo.

Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student in a two (2) or four (4) year institution whose programs are considered above the high school level. Full time is interpreted as twelve (12) semester hours per semester, undergraduate, or, nine (9) semester hours per semester, graduate. A transcript of records showing the most recent semester completed must accompany the application which must be received on or before April 1, 2015.

Applications for this \$2,000 award are reviewed by the committee after April 1 and are judged solely on the applicant's scholastic ability, career plans and community activities. No advantages are given the applicant based on his or her relationship to an ISM member. Only the chairperson of the committee knows the names of the applicants to insure non bias on the part of the committee.
