

Tour of Edwards Vacuum a Success

On May 6, 2015, members of ISM-Buffalo met at Edwards Vacuum for a tour of their impressive, 64,000 square foot facility. Edwards Vacuum is a global company, founded in 1919 in the United Kingdom. The Niagara County location of Edwards Vacuum employs a team of almost 200 people, and, impressively, contributes more than 25% of the global sales revenue. The company provides integrated engineered solutions such as vacuum products, and abatement systems. Their products are generally used as part of the overall manufacturing process of well-known products such as semi-conductors, LEDs and solar cells.

During our tour, Jeff Mickel, the Operations Manager responsible for the Niagara location, explained to us that the technology that Edwards Vacuum provides allows for the production of other products. For example, the company designs abatement systems to scrub manufacturing exhaust of harmful gasses and pollutants, allowing the gas to be returned to the environment safely. Their company also has the ability to create custom business solutions to fit the highly technical needs of many of its manufacturing customers. For example, they could design a vacuum that would be sensitive enough to secure a thin microchip.

During our tour, we were impressed by the company's dedication to safety; each of our members donned a reflective safety vest and safety glasses prior to entering the manufacturing area. We also noted the company's dedication to the environment. Edwards Vacuum not only creates environmental solutions, but also has internally approached a 100% recycling goal. The company has almost zero landfill waste, yet maintains a goal to convert their small amount of non-recyclable waste by burning and converting to energy.

Thank you to Edwards Vacuum for hosting our members. It's always a pleasure to understand how another industry operates in our neighborhood.

I was asked within the past week or so, how the job market looks for Supply Chain/Procurement professionals. I firmly believe and have seen firsthand, there are many advertisements for all job descriptions within the profession from CPO to purchasing coordinator. There is even a shift in hiring companies' posture; while procurement positions in true blue chip companies still entails a protracted slow process with hiring companies continuing to be highly selective, there are many positions where companies are finding it harder to get an adequate number of candidates. It seems, this will continue to be the case and I am increasingly receiving requests for resumes. I currently have resumes for a handful of members and continue to send these out upon employer requests, consistent with your direction on the registration form.
